

CARC Net Script

Net Control should ID a few minutes before Net Time

Net Introduction: ... Welcome to the Columbia Amateur Radio Club (**Wednesday** / Sunday) night net. Your Control Station tonight is (Your Call). The Columbia Amateur Radio Club conducts these nets on Sunday and Wednesday nights at 8:30PM. All licensed amateur radio operators are welcome to join us. The net can be heard on this local repeater: 147.330 located near Columbia South Carolina using a PL Tone of 156.7 hertz.

<PAUSE>

... This is NOT a call for Short time or any traffic other than Emergency or priority. At this time do we have any emergency or priority traffic for the net? If so, please call net control (*Your Call*) with your traffic. *Reply as needed.*

Routine Traffic ...The Columbia Amateur Radio Club net does not normally pass routine traffic. This is a discussion or information net. If you have routine traffic, please wait until the end of the net to pass your traffic.

Announcements ...At this time do we have any announcements for the net this evening? *Such as General Information, Events, Classes, ham fest or VE Testing, etc.* If so, please call net control (*your call*) with your call sign. *Thank the person for information given.*

... We will now take Mobile, Portable or first time check- ins. This is NOT a call for Short time stations. At this time do we have any portable, mobile or, first time check-ins wishing to check in this evening? If so, please call net control giving your call sign phonetically along with your name and location. Remember to wait for the courtesy tone before transmitting.

Acknowledge operators by name and call. Thank them for checking in.

Welcome any new check-in and give them some information about the CARC club and how to get additional information (w4cae.com). Ask them to stay after the net for any additional information.

Topics ... Before we begin taking routine check-ins think about our topic for the night which is ...

Routine Check-ins. ...We will take check-ins by grouping them in alphabetical order. If your suffix (the letter after the # in your call) is within the grouping being called for, it is your turn.

If you would like to check in Short time, tell Net Control *that you are short time and you will not be called for a comment.*

... At this time we will take check-ins for the following groups. A-L, Please call net control (*your call*) and give your call using standard phonetics along with your name and location. Please wait for the courtesy tone before transmitting. *Acknowledge each person checking in by name and call sign.*

Duplicate for call groups M-Z groups.

Do the above two or three times for both call groups. After several times, Request check-ins from all call groups

Closing ...Thanks to the ___ amateur radio operators who checked in tonight. Remember that you can check out upcoming events at W4CAE.org. Special thanks go to N7GZT, Phil, for the use of his repeater for the purpose of this net, and at this time I will return the repeater back to regular use. 73 to all. (your call) clear
